Regarding the Glenn Royall Mill Village National Register Historic District

The Town of Wake Forest and the Wake Forest Historic Preservation Commission have received concerns from Mill Village residents about recent development. We are conducting a survey to gain a better understanding of the concerns and to learn how the residents feel about the future of the Mill Village.

The survey can be completed in print (below) or online at wakeforestnc.gov (search “mill village survey”).

As a point of clarification, the Mill Village is a “National Register Historic District,” not a “Local Historic District.” A **National Register Historic District** is an honorary designation and offers very limited protection. A **Local Historic District** is a local ordinance that requires the Historic Preservation Commission to approve exterior changes.
