## Board of Adjustment

**PURPOSE:** To hear and decide appeals of the Administrator's enforcement or interpretation of the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO). The board may also authorize variances from the terms of the UDO that will not be contrary to the public interest and that meet specific findings of fact.

**TERM:** 3 yrs. (in-town), 2 yrs. (ETJ resident, appointed by the Wake County Board of Commissioners and the Wake Forest Board of Commissioners)

**MEETINGS:** As needed on the third Thursday of the month, 6 p.m. at town hall

## Historic Preservation Commission

**PURPOSE:** To safeguard the heritage of Wake Forest by preserving districts and landmarks that embody important elements of the town's culture, history, architectural history and to promote the use and conservation of such districts and landmarks for the education, pleasure and enrichment of all citizens.

**TERM:** 3 yrs.

**MEETINGS:** 6:30 p.m. on the second Wednesday of each month at town hall

## Human Relations Council

**PURPOSE:** To encourage understanding and goodwill between all Wake Forest citizens regardless of race, sex, religion, creed, nationality, or economic status, and thus promote the general welfare of the town.

**TERM:** 3 yrs.

**MEETINGS:** 6:30 p.m. on the fourth Thursday of each month at town hall

## Parks, Recreation & Cultural Resources Advisory Board

**PURPOSE:** To suggest policies and serve as liaison in matters affecting policies, programs and the acquisition and disposal of lands and properties related to the recreational program, and to its long-range projected programs. Members on this board represent one of three interest areas: Parks & Recreation, Cultural Resources or Greenways.

**TERM:** 3 yrs.

**MEETINGS:** 6:30 p.m. on the fourth Monday of each month at Flaherty Park Community Center

## Planning Board

**PURPOSE:** To hold joint public hearings with the board of commissioners and make recommendations to the board of commissioners on petitions related to rezonings, text amendments, special use permits and major site/subdivision master plans. The planning board may also recommend changes to the Unified Development Ordinance and the Community Plan.

**TERM:** 3 yrs. (in-town resident), 2 yrs. (ETJ resident, appointed by the Wake County Board of Commissioners and the Wake Forest Board of Commissioners)

**MEETINGS:** 6 p.m. on the second Tuesday of each month at town hall

## Public Art Commission

**PURPOSE:** To advise the board of commissioners about public art projects, planning and program management. The commission also recommends and implements public art policy and facilitates public participation, outreach, and communications concerning public art.

**TERM:** 3 yrs.

**MEETINGS:** 7 p.m. on the fourth Thursday of each month at the Renaissance Centre Arts Annex

## Technology Advisory Board

**PURPOSE:** To advise the Town in all areas related to technology and to spur economic development through technological growth by collaborating with business, industry, non-profits, public institutions and citizens.

**TERM:** 3 yrs.

## Urban Forestry Board
