

### Wake Forest Launching Microtransit October 1

Beginning October 1, the Town of Wake Forest will introduce a town-wide microtransit pilot program called "Go Wake Forest." Microtransit is a ridesharing transit service that operates similarly to Uber and Lyft, connecting riders directly to destinations from their doorstep. The current Wake Forest Loop Bus Service, operated by GoRaleigh, will be suspended during the new microtransit pilot program.
